**Please bring non-perishable food with you to the monthly meetings. Our Club supports the Blue Ridge Area Food Bank.**

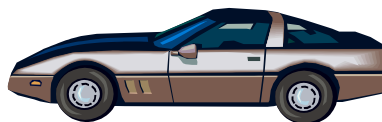
