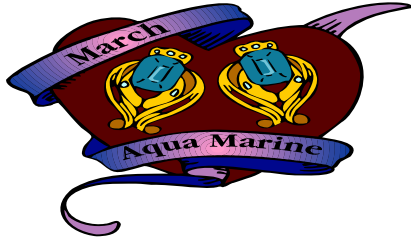

**ATTENTION:** Please remember at the March meeting the Club will be voting on an amendment to the By-Laws.

Below is a copy of the amendment that will be voted on.

**“Grandfather Clause”**

**ARTICLE IV: MEMBERSHIP,  
SECTION D: MEMBER AT LARGE**

A position of Member at Large shall be offered to those members who joined the Club owning a Corvette brand automobile and have stayed current with their dues, but for whatever reason, do not currently own a Corvette. The Member at Large may attend all meetings and Club functions and will receive the newsletter. A “Member at Large” may not hold an elected office and will have no voting privileges. A “Member at Large” who reacquires a Corvette brand automobile shall be converted back to Active Membership with full Club voting privileges.
