will be donated to Blue Ridge Hospice.



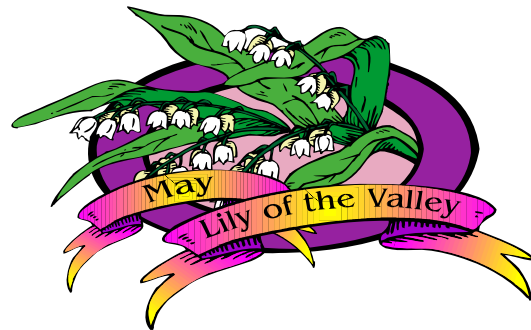
